



# Specialties

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## Deep Diving

This course helps you gain the experience needed for diving and also to help you become familiar with diving in excess of 30mts up to 40mts. You will be able to dive in areas with safety that previously you could not like for example exploring the remains of sunken ships as only one of the exciting possibilities.

## Nitrox

This course is designed for diving that will make you more secure with mixtures with high percentage of oxygen. If we do several dives the sense of fatigue is substantially reduced, which is very common in warm seas areas where repetitive dives are a reality. You will also learn how to manage these percentages within this course.

## Wreck Dives

The wreck dive is one of the most exciting dives; sites are often highly populated with marine life and usually deeper than usual. You will learn techniques of using films as a guide and how to move seemingly in a hostile environment, as well as control the time of immersion more scrupulously. In our area we have two wrecks: "El Feguere", a ship from the nineteenth century at a depth of 30mts and "The Marmolero", a steamship which is resting in a hole 50mts deep for 36 years. For this course you must have previous experience for diving very deep.

## Dry Suit

This course teaches you about the advantages of using dry suits such as dive safety, easy operation and comfort to stay dry and warm, even in extreme conditions, to make diving a real pleasure in any circumstances. This course is indispensable for those who want to start diving in caves and technical diving.

## Team Specialist

This course is devoted to equipment, technical relations and various forms of operation (an issue of high priority during any dive). Apexs, Cressi and Mares are our course preferences and with this course you will be able to solve small problems, how to always keep your PC in perfect condition and how to prevent common failures in the care of equipment (little tricks that will save you costly revisions).
